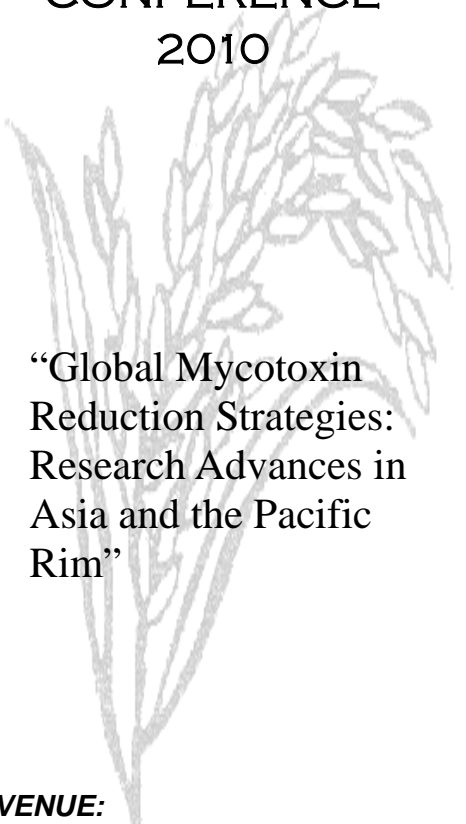
- * Eligibility to attend all sessions.
